

Rifle Range Rules as of June 2022

Access: This is a MEMBERS ONLY range. When on the range, your membership card must be displayed and visible. Shooting hours are 8am until dusk.

No vehicles are permitted downrange other than range personnel and handicapped persons with their personal ATV or golf cart.

Use:

- (1) Keep area clean. Remove targets when done shooting and dispose of casings.
- (2) There is ONE firing line, and all firing is to be from the cement pads under the firing line covers. Downrange movement **MUST BE COORDINATED** with all shooters, calling the range COLD prior to proceeding downrange, and calling the line HOT before shooting.
- (3) No handling of firearms is permitted behind the firing line. Muzzles must be pointed downrange, and no handling of firearms is permitted when anyone is downrange.
- (4) ONE bench per shooter
- (5) Children must be supervised at all times
- (6) No dogs are allowed.
- (7) No shooting at wildlife
- (8) No intoxicating beverages or controlled substances are permitted

Firearms and ammunition:

- (1) No full automatic weapons
- (2) No 50 BMG
- (3) No armor piercing, tracer, incendiary, exploding, or flechette ammunition is permitted

Targets:

- (1) Paper targets only on the provided backboards. Do not shoot the wooden target frame posts or cross members.
- (2) Steel targets provided by CF&G only.

Risk:

- (1) Individuals using the range do so at their own risk and assume all responsibility for injuries to persons and property done to or by them.
- (2) Eye and ear protection is mandatory when using firearms on club grounds.

Persons violating any of these rules will be subjected to loss of membership as prescribed by the Board of Directors.
